ELEMENT OF DANGER STATEMENT (Required for C.O.P.E., Climbing, and Voyager participants)

Project C.O.P.E. (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience), the Camp Friedlander Climbing and Rappelling tower, and the Voyager High Adventure program are designed to test mental and physical skills. As in any physical activity, there is an element of risk during these events.

If you are going to take part in C.O.P.E., Climbing, or Voyager activities, you must be aware of the possibility of injury. If you have any physical limitations or previous injury that could be aggravated by participation in any of the events, we recommend that you do not participate. These are **Challenge By Choice** events. In other words, you only participate in the activities you feel you can do. The director reserves the right to prevent you from participating in some events if he/she feels that you have limitations that might endanger you.
