Itinerary:

Units will be able to choose from different itineraries that reflect their specific goals or activities they may wish to participate in.

Sample itinerary: Monday: Small boat sailing Tuesday: Jet Skis Wednesday: Deep Sea fishing Thursday: Surfing lessons, beach time, Fort Macon Friday: Tubing and waterskiing. (Groups may tailor their week for more sailing, fishing, etc)

Additional Cost:

Some of the activities in OBX Adventure will have an additional cost such as Deep Sea Fishing and Shark fishing. Price range for these is \$45 - \$85 per person. <u>These activities are optional</u>.

Overview:

The OBX program is a more laid-back program compared to the Sea Kayaking Treks and Ironman. Participants will be living at the base camp and will be participating in a different activity each day.

Base Camp living:

Groups will be living at the base camp for the duration of the week. Facilities provide include a common room, shower house, and two man platform tents with cots. It is recommended that participants pack a mosquito net as a precaution. Participants will be able to plan and choose their own meals.

Group Size:

The group size of OBX Adventure is limited to 10 participants. The Sea Base will be operating two OBX Adventure Crews each will. These crews will have different schedules.

Jet Skis:

The Pamlico Sea Base is proud to be one of the few camps in the country to offer Boy Scouts a personal water craft program. Our OBX Adventure program is the Sea Base delivery of the Jet Skis. To operate a Jet Ski, participants are required under NC Law to be 14 years of age, show completion of a Boaters Safety Course and carry a photo id.
